PLUMBING APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

OPEN ENROLLMENT & SKIP TEST INFORMATION

The Maryland Plumbing-Heating-Cooling Contractors Apprenticeship program is fully accredited and registered with the Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Council, Department of Labor and Industry, registration number MATC 1430. Veteran Benefits. The program is approved for benefits as approved by the Veterans Administration.

Classes are held September through May, two evenings a week from 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m., 55 sessions, 165 hours per year. The curriculum covers Related Theory Instruction, Trade Mathematics, OSHA Subpart B Trenching Safety, General Safety, Adult First Aide, Adult CPR, Blue Print Reading, Gas and Plumbing Codes. Special courses: An extensive Journey Gas preparation course is included in our third year. The 32 Hour Backflow Certification course is included in our fourth year. The Maryland PHCC is an approved provider of training for both Natural Gas and Backflow Certification approved by the Maryland State Board of Plumbing. Apprentices must successfully complete and pass all four years in order to receive a Certificate of Graduation.

TRANSFER. An Applicant who has successfully completed a semester in an Apprenticeship Program registered with the Maryland Apprenticeship & Training Council may transfer their records and register to attend the Maryland PHCC Plumbing Apprenticeship program.

TUITION. Tuition includes all books and special courses.

SKIP TEST: If an applicant has 2,000 hours of documented work experience while working under the direct supervision of a State Licensed Master Plumber during a time period in which the applicant was registered with the Maryland State Board of Plumbing he/she is eligible to take the first year skip test. A grade of 75% or higher is required in order to skip the first year of the program. If an applicant has 4,000 hours of documented experience while working under the direct supervision of a State Licensed Master Plumber, and passes the first year skip test with a score of 85%, he/she is eligible to take a skip test for the second year. The second year test must be passed with a score of 75% or higher in order to enter the third year. No applicant may skip more than two years. Applicants must submit a letter verifying their hours signed by the Master Plumber along with a copy of his/her Maryland Apprentice license. **SKIP TEST: Registration deadline August 5, 2011**
